Pebbleware's "Green" Doughmakers Gourmet Bakeware selected for inclusion in the *Design Directions: Going Green* display at the 2008 International Home & Housewares Show

TERRE HAUTE, IN (March 2008) Pebbleware's Doughmakers Gourmet Bakeware was selected by the International Housewares Association (IHA) for inclusion in the *Design Directions: Going Green* display (<http://www.housewares.org/show/info/goinggreen.aspx>) at the International Home & Housewares Show, March 16-18, 2008. Doughmakers Gourmet Bakeware was the only bakeware chosen by IHA reviewers. The products were chosen because the sustainability warranted recognition by the Housewares community. Only 40 products were chosen for display amongst over 2,000 exhibiting companies. Pebbleware was allowed to display 3 products.

Pebbleware's Doughmakers Gourmet Bakeware has been manufactured in the United States for over 10 years from recycled aluminum. According to The Aluminum Association, "The use of recycled aluminum saves 95 percent of the energy, and avoids 95 percent of the emissions, associated with the production of the metal from ore, and it reduces the amount of waste consigned to landfills." Aluminum was chosen to produce Pebbleware's Doughmakers Gourmet Bakeware because it is lighter and more durable than steel, heats evenly and will not rust. The Original Pebble Pattern surface embossed on the bakeware is also made from recycled aluminum. This unique surface allows for baked goods to brown evenly and provides easy release.
